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1. Proposal

Substance name(s): 4,4'-[2,2,2-trifluoro-1-(trifluoromethyl)ethylidene]diphenol (BPAF, Bisphenol AF) and its salts

BPAF and its salts are proposed to be identified as substances meeting the criteria of Article 57 (c) of UK REACH owing to their classification in the hazard class toxic for reproduction category 1B¹.

Summary of how the substance meets the criteria set out in Article 57 of the REACH Regulation

4,4'-[2,2,2-trifluoro-1-(trifluoromethyl)ethylidene]diphenol (BPAF, Bisphenol AF) (EC: 216-036-7; CAS: 1478-61-1) is included in the GB Mandatory Classification and Labelling (MCL) list. It is covered by the Index number 604-099-00-7 and is classified as Toxic for reproduction category 1B (H360F: May damage fertility).

In addition, several BPAF salts are assigned the same classification on the basis that they will dissociate rapidly to BPAF in water or biological fluids. They include:

- Benzyl(diethylamino)diphenylphosphonium 4-[1,1,1,3,3,3-hexafluoro-2-(4-hydroxyphenyl)propan-2-yl]phenolate

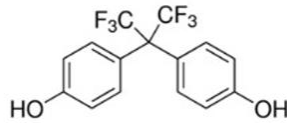
2. Justification

2.1 Identity of the substance and physical and chemical properties

2.1.1 Name and other identifiers of the substance

This report applies to 4,4'-[2,2,2-trifluoro-1 (trifluoromethyl)ethylidene]diphenol (BPAF) and its salts. The salts are expected to dissociate rapidly in water and biological fluids to form BPAF. Information on the identity of BPAF is provided in Table 1 and a non-exhaustive list of BPAF salts is provided in Table 2.

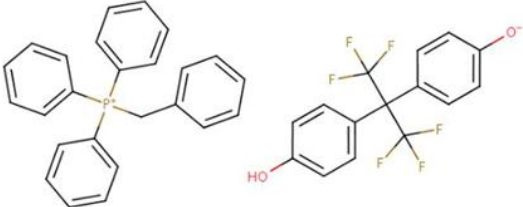
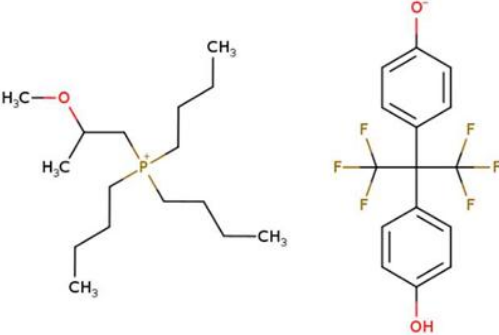
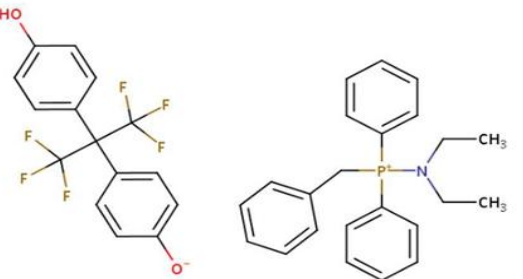

2.4 Conclusions on the SVHC properties

2.4.1 CMR assessment

BPAF is covered by the entry with Index number 604-099-00-7 in the GB MCL list and is assigned the hazard class toxic for reproduction category 1B (H360F: May damage fertility).

Several BPAF salts are likewise included in the GB MCL list with the same classification, including:

The classification is based on read-across from BPAF and the expectation that they will dissociate quickly to BPAF in water and biological fluids. As such, this proposal covers BPAF and its salts as the substances are considered to satisfy the criterion in Article 57 (c) of UK REACH.

3. Information on use, exposure and alternatives

3.1 UK and EU REACH registration status and tonnage

BPAF and the selected salts in this dossier are not currently registered under UK REACH.

Information regarding their registration status and tonnage (tonnes per annum; tpa) under EU REACH and number of Downstream User Import Notifications (DUINs)² submitted under UK REACH is provided in Table 4.

² GB-based companies who imported substances from EU-based suppliers before UK REACH became law on 1 January 2021 had no EU REACH registration obligations as they were classed as Downstream Users (DUs). As they are now importers from outside of GB, they may have registration obligations under UK REACH. However, a transitional measure allows former DUs to suspend the registration until one of three deadlines (depending on tonnage and hazard). Where the identity of these imported substances was known, they could be included in a Downstream User Import Notification (DUIN) submitted to the Agency.

It should be noted that the BPAF salts above are not an exhaustive list. DUINs and UK/EU REACH registrations may exist for BPAF salts that fall within the scope of this proposal but are not explicitly named.

3.2 General description of uses and exposure

BPAF and its salts are primarily used in industrial settings in the manufacture and processing of polymer materials and in rubber production and processing (ECHA, 2025). They may also be used as a crosslinking agents in fluoroelastomers and as a monomer in the production of specialty polymers, including polyimides, polyamides, polyesters and polycarbonate copolymers (ECHA, 2025). No uses by professional workers or consumers have been reported, and there is no indication of use in applications such as colour developers in thermal paper. However, it is possible that BPAF may be present in cured fluoroelastomeric articles.

BPAF and its salts are handled predominantly during formulation, compounding, and industrial processing activities, including mixing, blending, and incorporation into polymer matrices (ECHA, 2025).

Therefore, exposure is expected to occur primarily in occupational settings. As BPAF is often chemically bound within polymer matrices following curing or crosslinking, the potential for release during the service life of articles is expected to be limited. However, some available information indicates that residual, extractable, BPAF may be present in cured fluoroelastomer-based materials at low levels (ECHA, 2025).
